Marianne was born in Jasper on October 6, 1922 to Victor and Clara (Rumbach) Sturm. She married Joseph Fritch on February 9, 1957 in St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper. He preceded her in death on January 8, 1990. Marianne was a registered nurse anesthetist at Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper and St. Joseph's Hospital in Huntingburg for many years, and was also a registered nurse in the Army, serving during World War II. She also worked as a nurse for Dubois County Tri-Cap and was a school nurse for Jasper High School. She was a member of Precious Blood Catholic Church in Jasper, the Precious Blood Choir, the Precious Blood St. Vincent DePaul Society, the Memorial Hospital Auxillary, the American Legion Post #147 of Jasper, and the V.F.W. Post #673 of Jasper. She was also a Girl Scout Leader. She received the Simon Brute award from the Diocese of Evansville for her service in Precious Blood Parish.
