Marilyn M. Kress, age 79 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 2:50 p.m. on Saturday, December 22, 2018 at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Marilyn was born in Jasper, Indiana on October 1, 1939 to William and Elfrieda (Borho) Kreilein. She married David F. Kress on June 8, 1963 in St. Joseph Catholic Church in Jasper.

She retired from German American Bank in Jasper after 35 years of service where she was hired as the first female bank teller.

She was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper, and their CRHP group, the Jasper Circle of the Daughters of Isabella, a 56 year member of the Psi Iota Xi Zeta Mu Chapter Sorority, and the Jasper American Legion Post #147 Auxiliary.
