Mark "Rookie" Schneider, age 63 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday (May 15, 2016) at Select Specialty Hospital in Evansville, Indiana.

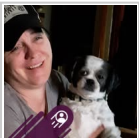
