Mary T. Fuhs, age 92 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 7pm on Thursday, February 3, 2022 at Northwood Retirement Community in Jasper, Indiana.

Mary was born in Marion Township, Dubois County, Indiana on August 30, 1929 to Albert and Rose (Schepers) Fromme. She married Leroy Fuhs on September 30, 1947 in St. Celestine Church. He preceded her in death on March 3, 2000.

She retired as a phone operator for Contel Telephone company in Seymour, and had previously worked as an operator for Contel in Jasper for over 25 years. After retirement she was instrumental in the startup of the Community Food Bank in Jasper, where she became their first manager.
