Mary Jane Humbarger, age 82 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 11:02 a.m. on Friday, October 11, 2019 at Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper, Indiana.

Jane was born in Washington, Indiana on June 1, 1937 to Harold and Zelma (Gordon) Gilliatt. She married Kent L. Humbarger on August 31, 1958 in Washington, Indiana. He preceded her in death on January 2, 2012.

Jane graduated from Vincennes University and then the Good Samaritan Hospital School of Nursing in 1958. She worked in nursing and volunteered with the American Red Cross as a nurse for the blood drives, and worked as a nurse for the Dubois County Child Protective Services Team.

Jane was a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church in Jasper, where she served on various committees.

She was a member of the Psi Iota Xi Sorority and she enjoyed knitting, crossword and word search books, reading, and crafts.
