Mary Catherine Mehringer, age 91, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 12:50 a.m. on Friday, December 6, 2019, at St. Charles Health Campus in Jasper, Indiana.

Mary Catherine was born in Jasper, Indiana, on July 14, 1928, to William and Rose (Schroering) Brosmer. She married Claude J. Mehringer on November 8, 1952 in St. Joseph Catholic Church. He preceded her in death on September 4, 1964.

Mary Catherine retired from Jasper Woodworking, where she worked in the office for many years.

She was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper where she was a member of their St. Ann's Sodality, and served as a Stephen Minister.
