Matthew R. Eyer, age 40, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away on Friday, January 10, 2025, at Ascension St. Vincent Hospital in Evansville, Indiana.

Matt was born in Crawfordsville, Indiana, on May 4, 1984, to Kenneth “Rick” and Beverly J. (Miller) Eyer. He married Abra Terwiske on April 12, 2008, at St Isidore Parish- St. Celestine Catholic Church.

He was a 2002 graduate of Crawfordsville High School. He was a natural athlete and played basketball, soccer, golf, baseball, and was in performing arts.

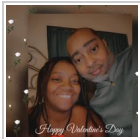
