Mildred A. Fischer, age 86 of St. Anthony, Indiana, passed away at 8:25 p.m. on Saturday (August 27, 2016) at Brookside Village in Jasper, Indiana.

Mildred was born in St. Anthony Indiana on November 4, 1929 to Paul and Anna (Vonderheide) Ehrman. She married William Fischer Sr. on June 10, 1950 in St. Anthony Catholic Church. He preceded her in death on November 10, 1983.
