Norbert C. Alles, age 90, of Jasper, Indiana passed away at 7:15 a.m. on Tuesday (April 21, 2015) at Northwood Retirement Community in Jasper, Indiana.

Norbert was born in Jasper, Indiana on July 6, 1924 to Jacob and Anna (Rasche) Alles. He married Margaret Krodel on June 9, 1951 in Our Lady of the Springs Catholic Church in French Lick, Indiana. She preceded him in death on November 12, 2011.

He served two and a half years in the Army during World War II with four of his brothers in the Army overseas. He received the following medals: Good Conduct, American Campaign, Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, European-African-Middle Eastern, World War II Victory, and the Honorable Service Button.

He was a graduate of Jasper High School in 1942. He started working at Wilson Drug Company in the summer of 1939 and during high school. He then went to Pharmacy School in 1942 and completed three semesters. He served in the Army and then went to Purdue University, where he graduated from the School of Pharmacy in 1949. He returned to Wilson Drug Company and later became a part owner. When the Central Building was sold and the drug store

closed, he worked at Flick's Drugs for five years and then retired.

He also served as a director and chairman of the board of Dubois County Bank and Old National Bank for many years.

He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper, the Jasper Country Club, V.F.W. Post #673, American Legion Post #147, Jasper K of C, Dubois County Sportsman Club, and the Dubois County Purdue Club.

He won nine consecutive club championships at the Jasper Country Club and 14 championships in all.

He enjoyed golfing, fishing, hunting, tennis, and all Purdue sports.
