Patricia "Pat" June Fritch, age 93, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 7:13 p.m. on Saturday, July 20, 2024, surrounded by family at Memorial Hospital and Health Care Center in Jasper, Indiana.

Pat was born in Chicago, Illinois, on August 19, 1930, to Victor and Celia (Schnell) Seger. She married James "Jim" L. Fritch on April 19, 1952, in Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana. He preceded her in death on February 17, 2020.

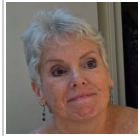
