Patricia J. "Pat" Sermersheim, age 78 of Ireland, Indiana, passed away at 11:15 p.m. on Wednesday, November 21, 2018 at Memorial Hospital and Healthcare Center in Jasper.

Pat was born on September 11, 1940 to Alfred J. and Mildred E. (Ebenkamp) Blessinger. She married James Sermersheim on September 29, 1960 in Holy Family Catholic Church. He preceded her in death on June 20, 2004.

Pat was graduate of the Jasper High School Class of 1958 and was a homemaker and also worked as a teaching aid at Ireland Elementary School for over 30 years.
