Paul C. Schitter, age 83 of Ireland, Indiana, passed away at 5:50 a.m. on Sunday, June 3, 2018 at Northwood Retirement Community in Jasper, IN.

Paul was born in Ireland, Indiana on December 25, 1934 to Harry and Laura (Burke) Schitter. He married Alma Sendelweck on June 18, 1955 in St. Mary's Catholic Church in Ireland.

He worked as a truck driver for Martin Renner Corporation for many years, and then retired from the Dubois County Highway Department.

He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Ireland, a lifetime member of the Ireland Sportsman's Club, a charter member of the Ireland Knights of Columbus, a member of the Jasper Moose Lodge 1175 and the Ireland Historical Society.

Paul played baseball and basketball in high school, and then played baseball for the Ireland Merchants in the Deer Trail League for over 20 years. He was a lifelong bowler, an avid hunter and fisherman, and an avid St. Louis Cardinals and Indiana Pacers fan.
