Richard P. "Rich" Meyer, age 84 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 3:10 p.m. on Tuesday, January 28, 2020 at Legacy Living in Jasper, Indiana.

Rich was born on April 2, 1935 in Dubois County to Hilbert and Della (Bair) Meyer. His father died when Rich was very young and his mother married Harold Englet who became a father to Rich.
