Rita A. Gress, age 89, of Ireland, Indiana, passed away at 9:17 a.m. on Wednesday, June 10, 2020, at home.

Rita was born in Jasper, Indiana, on September 11, 1930, to Albert and Frances (Hauser) Fehribach. She married Lee A. Gress on April 22, 1950, in St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Jasper, Indiana. He preceded her in death on July 19, 2015.

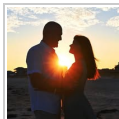
