Robert J. Beckman, age 84 of Jasper, Indiana passed away at 11:02 a.m. Wednesday, July 17, 2019 at his home.

He was a graduate of Jasper High Class 1952. He was a US Air Force Veteran serving from 1953 to 1957 during the Korean War serving in Guam.
