Russell Herbert Grant, age 88, of Santa Claus, Indiana, passed away at 1:25 a.m. on Wednesday, June 21, 2017, at Scenic Hills Care Center in Ferdinand, Indiana.

Russell was born in Plainfield, NJ, on September 7, 1928, to Andrew H. and Rosella M. (Chickering) Grant. He married Martha Ann "Marty" Koch on October 16, 1976 in Vincennes, IN.

Russell was a U.S. Navy WWII Veteran and worked as a field engineer for Cincinnati Milacron.

He was a member of St. Francis of Assisi Parish - St. Nicholas Catholic Church in Santa Claus, Indiana and the Santa Claus American Legion.

He enjoyed playing golf, travel, and woodworking.
