



## Silvera L. Renner

September 24, 1927 - February 2, 2023

Silvera “Vera” L. Renner, age 95, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 1:30 a.m. on Thursday, February 2, 2023, at Legacy Living in Jasper, Indiana.

Vera was born in Jasper, Indiana, on September 24, 1927, to Simon and Marie (Blessinger) Ackerman. She married, Donald E. Renner on May 6, 1954, in St. Joseph Catholic Church in Jasper.

She graduated from Ireland High School in 1945. In 1952, she went on and received her Bachelor’s Degree from Nazareth School of Nursing in Louisville, Kentucky.
