Starr L. Kieffner, age 74 of Haysville, Indiana, passed away at 9:55 p.m. on Friday, December 7, 2018 at home.

Starr was born in Huntingburg, Indiana on May 13, 1944 to Lee and Emadean (Schmeltekope) Broeker. She married Robert L. Kieffner on January 2, 1965 in Salem United Church of Christ in Huntingburg. He preceded her in death on February 20, 1990.
