Thomas J. Bachman, age 92, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 5:29 a.m. on Thursday, June 15, 2023, at The Timbers in Jasper, Indiana.

Tom was born in Dubois, Indiana on July 13, 1930, to Albert and Eleanor (Seeger) Bachman. He married Charlene Judy on May 5, 1956, in St. Joseph Catholic Church in Jasper. She preceded him in death on January 10, 2020.
