Verlin C. Kenworthy, age 91 of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 2:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 14, 2018 at Northwood Retirement Community in Jasper, Indiana.

Verlin was born in Richmond, Indiana on September 27, 1926 to Robert and Hazel (Bryant) Kenworthy. He married Naomi Stetter on September 13, 1951 in St. Ann's Catholic Church in Mars Hill, IN

Verlin served in the U.S. Navy in WWII and the Korean War. He was a lifetime member and past Post Commander of the VFW Post #673 and served on their Honor Guard Detail.

Verlin was in the automotive tool business throughout his life, working for Sun Equipment, then selling Snap-On and Matco tools, and retiring from Jasper Engines.

He was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Jasper.
