Veronica C. "Fronie" Hochgesang, age 96 of St. Anthony, Indiana, passed away at 9:05 p.m. on Tuesday, January 21, 2020 at home surrounded by her family.

Fronie was born in Schnellville, Indiana on October 24, 1923 to Joseph and Mathilda (Gunselman) Brosmer. She married August X. Hochgesang on April 22, 1941 in Sacred Heart Catholic Church. He preceded her in death on September 5, 1992.
