Victor L. "Vic" Eckstein, age 84, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, April 25, 2022, at home surrounded my family.

Vic was born in Jasper, Indiana, on October 21, 1937, to Victor R. and Lorena E. (Jaent) Eckstein. He married Elnore "Ellie" Shearrow on November 28, 1959, in Lady of Lords Catholic Church in Dobie Wisconsin.

Vic worked at Jasper Memorial Hospital where he was a laboratory technician. He was one of the first EMTs. He retired after 35 years of service.
