Wayne L. Woebkenberg, age 82, of Carmel, Indiana, formerly of Jasper, passed away surrounded by family at 5:58 a.m. on Wednesday, January 29, 2025, at Bridgewater Health Care Center in Carmel, Indiana.

Wayne was born in Ferdinand, Indiana, on August 20, 1942, to Roman and Violet (Vaal) Woebkenberg. He married Martha Moeller on May 17, 1969, at St. Ferdinand Catholic Church.
