Dateline Jasper, Indiana Wilfred A. Weinzapfel, age 73, passed away at 1:15 p.m. Saturday (October 20, 2012) at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts. He was born on September 27, 1939 in St. Philip, IN to Alfred and Magdalen (Wannemuehler) Weinzapfel. He married Betty J. Flamion on February 27, 1960 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Evansville, Indiana. Wilfred worked at Ruxer Ford-Lincoln-Mercury in Jasper for 35 years, 20 of which he was part owner, until his retirement in 1995. He was a former Director of Jasper State Bank, former member of the board and treasurer of the Catholic Foundation of Southwestern Indiana, and past president of the Holy Family Catholic School Foundation. He is a 1957 graduate of Mater Dei High School and a 1961 graduate of Evansville College (currently University of Evansville), where he attended on a football scholarship.
