William A. "Whitey" Nordhoff, age 75, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away at 6:18 a.m. on Saturday, May 6, 2017, at Select Specialty Hospital in Evansville, Indiana.

Whitey was born in Evansville, Indiana on July 17, 1941 to Clemence A. and Mary June (Cave) Nordhoff. He married Carmen Joan Hendrixson on November 16, 1961, in Our Lady of Springs Catholic Church in French Lick, Indiana.
