Dateline Dubois, Indiana Wilmer G. Kreitzer, age 93 of Dubois, Indiana, passed away at 8:45 a.m. on Saturday (May 3, 2014) at Brookside Village in Jasper, Indiana. Wilmer was born in rural Dubois County Indiana on December 5, 1920 to George and Sophia (Harker) Kreitzer. He married Janice Zehr on May 8, 1945 at St. Peter's Church in Dubois, Indiana. Wilmer worked for Midwest Manufacturing, which later became the Jasper Corporation and Kimball International for 40 and 1/2 years. He was a Navy Veteran who served during World War II in the Pacific Theater from 1942 to 1946. He made 5 trips across the Pacific during his service. He was a member of St. Peter's United Church of Christ in Dubois since April of 1946, in which he held many offices and sang in the choir. He was a member of the VFW Post #673. He served on the board of the Dubois Water Utilities for over 40 years. He was a member of the Dubois Volunteer Fire Department from 1954 to 1977, a member of the Dubois Community Club, the Dubois Development Corp., and a past member of the Harbison Township Trustee Advisory Board.
