Zane C. Winger, age 82 of Dubois, Indiana, passed away at 4:15 a.m. on Wednesday (August 5, 2015) at Brookside Village in Jasper, IN.

Zane was born at French Lick, Indiana on January 16, 1933 to Philip and Carrie (Deremiah) Winger. He married Imogene Voelkel on September 3, 1955 in St. Peter's United Church Christ in Dubois.

He was a graduate of French Lick High School Class of 1951. After high school he worked as a machine apprentice at New York Central Railroad in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Zane retired from ANR Pipeline Company at Celestine, Indiana where he had worked for 30 years.

He was a U.S. Army Veteran who served in Korea, and was a lifetime member of the VFW Post #673 and the American Legion Post #147 in Jasper.

He was a member of St. Peter's United Church of Christ in Dubois, IN.

He was a member of the Masonic Line Lodge #743 in Jasper, IN. He received the 50 year pin from the Masonic Lodge where he had previously served as Worshipful Master.

In his younger days he enjoyed flying Piper Cub Airplanes. He was active and served as President in a lot of local clubs such as Dubois Community Club, Dubois Jaycees and the Dubois Town Board.
